From 2005 to 2010, she was educated in cognitive-behavioral psychotherapy, run by the Croatian Association for Behavioral-Cognitive Therapies. In 2015, she became a subspecialist of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry and Psychotherapy and received the title Primarius.
