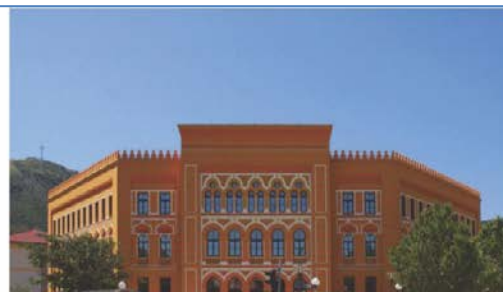

He is Psychiatrist, Assistant Professor at the Department for Psychiatry of School of Medicine (University of Belgrade), with professional position of Head of Clinical Trials Unit at the Institute of Mental Health Belgrade.

Graduated at the School of Medicine, University of Belgrade on 1991, MSc degree obtained in 1995 (at the Center for Multidisciplinary Studies, University of Belgrade), final exam after training in Psychiatry (1997) and PhD degree (2001) obtained at the School of Medicine, University of Belgrade. Professional career started in Special Psychiatric Hospital “Dr Laza Lazarević# Belgrade (1993 – 2001), and continues in the Institute of Mental Health Belgrade where held several positions (Head of Department for Psychotic Disorders, Head of the Clinical Trials Unit and Head of Outpatient Department. He was Assistant Dr. from 2011 - 2018 and is Assistant Professor from 2018 at the School of Medicine, University of Belgrade.

Published great number of professional and scientific papers, involved in several clinical trials and had active participation on many scientific meetings in the country and abroad.

He is President of the Serbian Psychiatric Association (from 2023), and since 2018 is Head of the Health Council of the Religious Charitable Guardianship of the Archbishopric of Belgrade-Karlovac of the Serbian Orthodox Church and a member of the Hilandar Medical Society.
