



Zihnet Selimbašić

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He was born in 1959 in Pauč, municipality of Kladanj. He graduated from the Faculty of Medicine in Tuzla in 1986, specializing in neuropsychiatry in 1995. Education in the field of child and adolescent trauma psychology and psychiatry at Missouri University, USA in 1995. In 1997, he completed his education in "Trauma and Human Development" in cooperation with Harvard Public School, the University of Rijeka, and the University of Sarajevo, and in 1998, in cooperation with UNICEF, his education in post-traumatic therapy. Training in supervision methods in cooperation with the Division of Clinical Neuroscience and Psychiatry, Gothenburg, Sweden for Clinical Supervision in 2000. He completed his postgraduate studies in 2002. He defended his master's thesis in 2005 at the Center for Interdisciplinary Studies of the University of Sarajevo. He defended his doctoral dissertation in 2011 at the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Tuzla. He participated in the psychosocial programs "Help to children and adults killed in the war and after the war" from 1994 to 2004, as well as "Exchange of experiences of helpers/therapists from Bosnia and Herzegovina and Germany" from 1999 to 2001. Acquired the title of group analyst in 2012. Since 2009, he has been the head of the Day Hospital of the Psychiatry Clinic of the JZU UKC Tuzla. Since 2011, he has been an assistant professor, and since 2019, an associate professor in the subject "Psychiatry with medical psychology" at the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Tuzla.
